

Table Tennis Rules

All participants must have & show their valid KENT STATE UNIVERSITY ID before the start of every game. Anyone without an ID will not be allowed to participate. No exceptions.

All games shall be self-officiated and played in accordance with the USA Table Tennis Rules; which will be in effect unless otherwise noted in this supplement. For a complete list of playing rules, click on the above link or visit <http://www.usatt.org/rules/index.shtml>.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The table tennis tournament is a one-day event that may require multiple matches being played.
- All participants that advance in the bracket should not leave the SRWC and should stay in the immediate area.
- The brackets are just a guide, specific times will change based on the time it takes to play the match. We will do whatever it takes to keep the games going as quickly as possible.
- All matches will be self officiated.
- A game shall be won by the player or pair first scoring 21 points unless both players or pairs score 20 points. If this occurs, the game shall be won by the player or pair first scoring subsequently 2 points more than the opposing player or pair.
- After each 5 points have been scored the receiving player or pair shall become the serving player or pair and so on until the end of the game, unless both players or pairs have scored 20 points. In this instance, each player shall serve for only 1 point in turn.
- A match shall consist of the best of 3 games.
- These tournaments are single elimination.
- Evaluations should be completed by any and all participants. Evaluations will be provided to you immediately following play.
- Championship t-shirts will be awarded to the singles champion(s) as well as the doubles champions.
